Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Namakkal, is a centre for transfer of technologies from lab to various groups like Farming Community, Self Help Groups, Rural Youth, Extension Personnel etc., through organizing various events like Trainings, On Farm Testings, Front Line Demonstrations and Advisory services regularly. To impart the scientific skills and knowledge among the farm women, farmers & physically challenged people and to adopt the scientific technologies in their farms, KVK has conducted various training programmes, awareness campaigns, exhibitions, demonstrations, field days and camps during the period. The work done particulars from April to June 2019 is presented hereunder.

Awards

KVK, Namakkal has received award for the best performance in NICRA project (2018-19) from the Deputy Director General, Agricultural Extension, ICAR during inaugural session of ICAR Annual Zonal review workshop for KVKs of Zone-10 (Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu & Puducherry) held at NAARM Campus, Hyderabad from 24 - 26 May, 2019 by ATARI, Hyderabad on 24.05.2019. Also the kendra received two awards for best oral presentation and poster presentation from the Vice Chancellor, Telangana Agricultural University during the plenary session of the workshop on 26.05.2019.



This Kendra also bagged "BEST NICRA KVK AWARD 2019" in recognition and appreciation of its best efforts in implementing the NICRA – Technology demonstration Component of Indian Council of Agricultural Research from Deputy Director General (Agrl. Extension) during NICRA Annual Zonal review workshop for NICRA KVKs held at CRIDA Campus, Hyderabad from 04-06 June 2019.

World Environment Day 2019

KVK, Namakkal has celebrated World Environment Day at Government High School of NICRA village-Jambumadai and KVK premises on 05.06.2019. Awareness about tree plantation, & its impact on environment pollution and creation of plastic free environment was emphasized to school children and planted tree saplings around the school, villages and KVK premises. The Public Relationship Officer to Collector of Namakkal District also



participated and felicitated the event by planting tree saplings.

Fifth International Yoga Day, 2019

Fifth International Yoga Day, 2019 was conducted at KVK, Namakkal on 21.06.2019 with 40 farmers and 20 KVK staffs. Two Yoga and Naturopathy doctors from Namakkal government hospital came and taught general yogasanas, piranayama, meditation and general relaxation exercise to the participants between 8.30 am to 9.45 am. Handouts on importance of yoga were distributed to the participants.



Animal Health Camp

KVK, Namakkal has conducted training on livestock health management and deworming and vaccination camp at two places in Ondikkadai (DFI village) on 25.06.2019 under convergence with Poultry Disease Diagnosis and Surveillance Laboratory (PDDSL) of TANUVAS. Totally 84 cattle, 196 goats dewormed and 78 desi chicken vaccinated against Ranikhet disease. Mineral mixture, antiseptics, dewormer's and training manuals distributed to the farmers. In this training programme 83 livestock owners were benefited.

Paid training

KVK, Namakkal has conducted one day paid training on Vermicompost production technology on 27.05.19 with 17 participants of Muthayammal College Students, Namakkal. Students were imparted about the importance and need of Vermicomposting, worm's selection, residue addition, water management, sieving techniques and qualities of vermicompost.



On campus training

From April 2019 to June 2019, sixteen on campus trainings were conducted at KVK, Namakkal to 400 farmers. Minor millet production practices and value addition methods, recent production techniques in small onion & mango, organic agriculture and organic liquid manure preparations, green fodder production and hydroponic fodder techniques, integrated nutrient management for groundnut, castor and sesame, tomato, brinjal and chillies, Integrated pest & disease management in fruit & cotton crops, mushroom production techniques, concentrate feed preparation, goat Rearing, desi chicken rearing, GIFT Tilapia seed production and culture technology, backyard ornamental fish culture and value added fish products were the major areas covered in these training programmes.



Extension Functionaries training

KVK, Namakkal has conducted training for Extension functionaries on Recent production and post harvest techniques in Small onion to 23 Horticulture and Assistant Horticulture Officers from Dept. of Horticulture, Namakkal on 16.04.19. Extension officers were gained scientific skills from land preparation to post harvest technologies in small onion.



Off campus training

Based on the need of farmers, two off campus trainings entitled integrated crop management practice in groundnut and fall army worm management in maize were conducted to 72 farmers and educated complete scientific information in above topics.



Zonal workshop

A Monthly zonal workshop for agricultural department officials was conducted on 11.06.2019 at KVK, Namakkal to 43 extension officials. Scientist of KVK, Namakkal has delivered season oriented technical lectures and major field problem in different blocks of Namakkal district were discussed and suggestions were recommended.



Soil & water analysis & issue of soil health cards

Since April to June 2019, 146 soil samples & 33 water samples received and tested. Totally 146 soil health cards and 33 water health cards issued to farmers with suitable recommendation. To improve the fertility status of soil, farmers were advised to practice green manuring, biofertilizers & micronutrient application along with regular macro nutrient application.



Exposure visit

During this quarter, a total of 345 participants (284 farmers and 61 students from Chattogram Veterinary University, Bangladesh) were made exposure visit to this Kendra and got technical and practical guidance about the technologies available in instructional and demo units.
